

Live Prosthesis 360° - International Course

OBJECTIVES

In the past decade, fixed prosthodontics has changed in many ways, from the application of digital technology to the development of new restorative materials that have finally made possible the application of innovative clinical protocols.

Aim of the following course is the presentation of a new and efficient prosthetic protocol (Simplified Prosthetic Protocol-SPP) that will make restorative dentistry more user-friendly and faster for the beginner as well as for the trained dentist.

This protocol and the related key-elements have been successfully applied on natural teeth as well as on implants for more than 10 years, and clinical research and follow-ups have scientifically validated the procedures that will be explained step-by-step during this course.

The Live Prostheses 360° program has been an important part of the scientific activity of Lake Como Institute for many years and has been divided into a "3-day course" to guarantee a detailed didactical phase mixed with a live presentation on patients both on teeth and implants.
